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**REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISION TO NURSING PROGRAM**

- ① Meet all admission standards established in the General Catalog.
- ② Have a minimum GPA of 2.50 in high school or place of origin.
- ③ To be eligible for third year courses must have sucessfully completed the requirements of the first two years of the Bachelor of Sciene in Nursing from a recognized and accredited institution of higher education. Candidates who bring an associate degree must complete all general education requirement established by the institution.
- ④ Present at the moment of the admission to the program evidence of any permanent license acquired.

**REQUISITES FOR CLINICAL PRACTICE AGENCY**

- ① Criminal record negative effect issued by the Police of Puerto Rico.
- ② Health certificate valid for one year issued by the Department Health.
- ③ Evidence for Hepatitis B-Vaccines.
- ④ Evidence of varicella or chickenpox titles.
- ⑤ Some agencies and courses have additional requirements, such as: current CPR certification, negative doping test, nose and throat culture, negative certification of sex offender.

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For the Associate Degree in Nursing students are required to complete 50% of the major credits in the campus from which they expect to receive the degree. This also applies to the Bachelor's Degree.
